Numbers 2018-93 & 2018-93-1  
Status: Adopted Final on May 1, 2019.

### **13.1.1.1 Time Period for Off Campus Contacts -- General Rule.**

Off-campus recruiting contacts shall not be made with an individual (or his or her family members) before August 1 at the beginning of his/her junior year in high school. (previous was before July 1 following the completion of junior year of high school)

### **13.1.3 Time Period for Telephone Calls - General Rule: Telephone Calls to an individual and/or his/her family members)**

Telephone calls to an individual and/or their family members may not be made before June 15 at the conclusion of his/her sophomore year in high school

#### **13.1.3.2.4 Telephone Calls from an Individual**

An institutional staff member (DI Coaching Staff) may not receive telephone calls from an individual and/or his/her family members before June 15 at the conclusion of his/her sophomore year in high school.

### **13.4.1 Recruiting Materials & Electronic Correspondence - General Rule:**

An institution shall not provide recruiting materials, including general correspondence related to athletics or send electronic correspondence to an individual and/or his/her family until June 15 at the conclusion of his/her sophomore year.

#### **13.6.2.1.1 First Opportunity to Visit. (Official Paid Visit)**

A prospective student-athlete may not be provided an expense-paid visit earlier than August 1st of his/her junior year in high school.

#### **13.7.1.1 First Opportunity to Visit (Unofficial Nonpaid Visit)**

An unofficial visit with athletics department involvement (e.g. contact with athletics department staff, athletics-specific tour, complimentary admission) shall not occur with an individual or (his/her family members) before August 1st at the beginning of his/her junior year in high school.

**13.12.1 Institution's Sports Camps and Clinics****13.12.1.5.1 Exception -- Recruiting Conversations**

Recruiting conversations during an institutional camp or clinic (including a camp or clinic that involves only individuals who are not yet prospective student-athletes) are not permitted between an institution's coach and a participating individual before September 1 at the beginning of the individual's junior year in high school.

**2018-93-1** was 'Adopted as Final' to remove the amendment restricting oral offers of aid.

**Rationale:** There are some concerns with the enforceability of limiting oral offers of aid until a date that occurs after the first opportunity for a coach to communicate with a prospective student-athlete. By removing the restriction on oral offers of aid, the proposal will allow such offers to occur on the first opportunity for a coach to communicate with a prospective student-athlete.
